

HE Bursary Scheme 2019-2020



Applicants must:

- a) Be actively participating in a Bournemouth & Poole College HNC, HND or Foundation Degree programme on a full time basis
- b) Be paying the 2019-20 Tuition fee of £6,000
- c) Be in receipt of the full student Maintenance Grant
- d) Be registered as a UK student
- e) Meet the appropriate income criteria as set by The Bournemouth & Poole College and recorded on 31.08.18. The Income information is calculated by Student Finance England and passed on to Bournemouth & Poole College.

Due to the limited Bursary allocation, meeting the eligibility criteria does not automatically qualify an application for a Bournemouth & Poole Maintenance or Care Leavers Bursary. Therefore if you know that your family income falls below £25,000, we recommend you apply for this support as soon as you accept your offer of a place at The College.

There are two types of bursary that are on offer. The details of both Bursaries are:

Bursary Title: The Bournemouth and Poole College Maintenance Bursary

Mode of Attendance: Full time

Fee Category: Home UK only

Level of Study: HND or Foundation Degree (Level 4 only—Top up students are excluded)

Criteria: Family income must be less than £25,000 as per Student Finance England data 31/08/19
Applicants must have a UCAS status or either U/F or C/F for a Bournemouth & Poole College course at the time of the Bursary application
Applicants or the applicant's family must be responsible for their own fees and living expenses

Value of Award: £2,000 for Year 1 only

Exclusions: Students funded by Scottish, Welsh and North Irish Governments
Students from outside of England (eg EU or International)

Bursary Title: The Bournemouth and Poole College Care Leavers Bursary

Mode of Attendance: Full time

Fee Category: Home UK only

Level of Study: HND or Foundation Degree (Level 4 only—Top up students are excluded)

Criteria: Applicants must have been in full-time care for a period of 3 months or more in the last 5 years. Family income must be less than £25,000 as per Student Finance England data (June 2019). Applicants must have a UCAS status of either U/F or C/F for a Bournemouth and Poole College course at time of Bursary application. Applicants or the applicant's family must be responsible for their own fees and living expenses.

Value of Award: £2,000 for Year 1
£2,000 for Year 2

Exclusions: Students funded by Scottish, Welsh and North Irish Governments
Students from outside of England (eg EU or International)
Students who have previously studied HE (including Top-up students)

Payment: Cash Payment into bank account £2,000 (Year 1 only) paid in 3 equal instalments in October, January and April by BACS .
